We will use atlases, Google Earth and Google Expeditions to help us locate them.

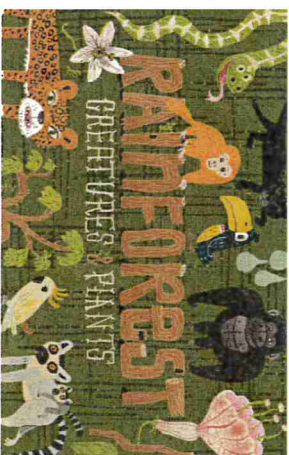
Could you survive life in the Rainforest?

Sumatra, Indonesia



We will be learning about the layers of the rainforest and finding out about the animals that inhabit in each layer. We will create our own rainforest in the classroom and explore the layers of our school woods.

Where is Sumatra?

We will compare Sumatra and England by looking at the similarities and differences.

Palm Oil

We will find out:

- What palm oil is and why it is used
- The products that contain palm oil
- The impact of palm oil plantations on the habitats, people and the animals of Sumatra
- How we can help and consider the difference we can make

Why Sumatra?

We will explore the key animals of Sumatra – tigers, orangutans and pygmy elephants. We will find out about the indigenous people and how they live in the rainforest. We will learn about the impact humans have on the rainforest.

We will also be:

- In Science, we will be learning about plants. We have lots of exciting investigations planned which will make the most of our wonderful school grounds
- In ICT, the children will create PowerPoint presentations about Sumatra which they will share at their celebration event
- In Art, the children will be exploring water colours and textiles
