

Dear Parents and Carers,

Upcoming Year 6 Opportunities

As Year 6 approach the end of their Berrywood journey, we are happy to be able to share with you the exciting opportunities and experiences lined up. This includes two school visits. The first of these is a day trip to the YMCA activity centre at Fairthorne Manor. This will allow the children to undertake a range of physical activities, with a focus on overcoming personal challenge and teamwork, and will hopefully go some way in making up for the disappointment of missing out on a residential trip this year. We would like this trip to take place on the 20th May

In order to confirm the date for the trip to Fairthorne Manor, a deposit of £15 per child is required. Given current restrictions, we are asking for all payments to be made online using your scopay account. The total cost for the day will be £40. This will be a full day of activities, running from 9.00am to 5.00pm with each child having the opportunity to take part in four different activities. Once the date has been confirmed, we will be able to finalise details, including final payment, and will send out further correspondence. Please could deposits be paid by **Friday 12th March at the latest.**

The second visit, part of our Theme Park Maths project in the summer term, is to Paultons Park. As well as enjoying the rides, the children will also take part in a workshop focussed on the computer programming side of running and operating a theme park. This trip is booked and the date confirmed for 19th July. The total cost per child, including the coach journey will be approximately £20. Further information and the request for payment for this will be sent out at a later date.

Children will also have the chance to take part in the Bikeability course during the week commencing the 14th June. This will be fantastic chance for the children to not only develop their road awareness but also encourage greater physical activity. There may be a £5 cost involved in this, but again further information, including the option to sign up to the course, will be sent out at a later date. Leaver's hoodies will also soon be available to order, with a specific letter for this, outlining costs, on its way soon.

We really do hope these experiences will help give the children a fantastic end to their Berrywood journeys. As we navigate our way through the upcoming weeks and months, we will be able to say with more confidence and certainty what the end of year 6 performance and leavers assembly will entail. At the moment, all we are asking for is the £15 deposit to secure the trip to Fairthorne, but we are sure there is plenty else for the children to be looking forward to.
