Clubs run by External Companies

Some of these clubs have been established at Berrywood for some time and are run by external companies.

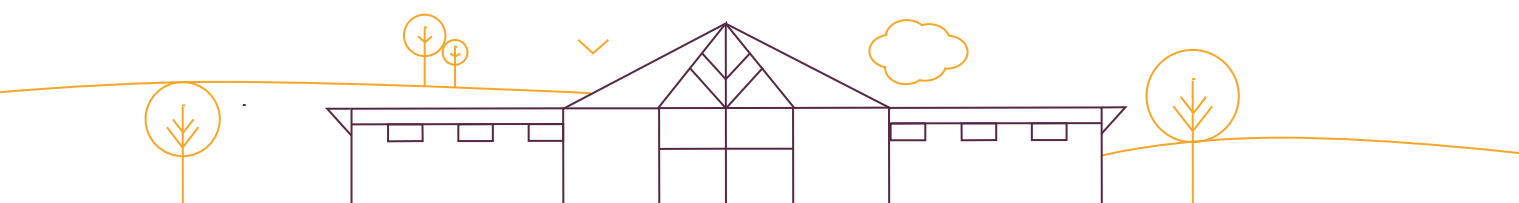
If your child is in receipt of benefit related Pupil Premium funding, your child can attend two extra-curricular sports clubs per week for free. Please note there is an expectation that your child attends these sessions as the school are invoiced, regardless of whether your child attends or not. Attendance will be monitored and if sessions are missed without a valid reason, funding for future sessions may be withdrawn.

Karate - this is a long established and ongoing club at Berrywood, that runs every Monday throughout the school year. Children are taught non-contact karate by fully qualified instructors. Dance Junkies - this is a long established street dance club that runs on Tuesdays throughout the school year at a cost of £6.00 per session. Annaleigh has been running this club for 19 years across Hampshire Schools. As well as being a qualified dancer, she has worked under choreographers from strictly and has been a backing dancer for many famous bands. She tries to use her professional experience to not only teach and inspire children, but also to have a lot of fun. There is a session for the younger children running straight after school and then an offer for older children in years 4, 5 and 6 that runs straight after the session for younger children. CM Sports Clubs: All coaches are fully qualified. We are subsidising this club with Sports grant money, meaning that the cost to families for each session is reduced from £6.00 to £4.50 (no charge for children in receipt of benefit related Pupil Premium funding). Please see the attached e-leaflets from CM Sports for booking details.

- **Multi-sports** – This takes place on a Thursday for children in years 1, 2 and 3.
- **Gymnastics** - This club will provide gymnastic opportunities with specific physical skill development. It will run on a Wednesday for children in years 4, 5 and 6.
- **Football** - This club will provide an opportunity for Berrywood children to develop their skills in the ever popular game of football. It will run on a Friday for children in years 1 to 6.

For children in Year 1, CM Sports are offering the first session of the term as a taster session. Please note limited spaces will be available. The attached flier contains all of the information you will need.

Tennis – This popular club will continue in the new academic year run by aj's Tennis Academy. The coach is fully qualified. We are subsidising this club with Sports grant money, meaning that the cost to families for each session is reduced from £7.00 to £5.50 (no charge for children in receipt of benefit related Pupil Premium funding). Computing Club – Computer Xplorers have been working at Berrywood for a number of years supporting with our KS2 computing curriculum. They will be continuing with their after-school club for the autumn term at a cost of £9.00 per session. Please see the attached e-leaflet for booking information.

Rocksteady – Rocksteady will be continuing at Berrywood in the Autumn term. Lessons take place during the school day, instruments are provided and no experience is necessary. Children can choose from drums, guitar, bass, keyboard or vocals. Please see the attached flyer for more information.
