Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to let you know that Year 4 will be taking part in a School Sleepover on Friday 24th April, linked to their current project learning about the Arctic.

This special experience is designed to support your child's independence, confidence and self-esteem, while also preparing them for future residential trips and creating core Berrywood memories.

During the sleepover, the children will take part in a range of engaging activities, including:

- Navigating Berrywood using a map
- A scavenger hunt
- A team quiz where they will apply their survival skills and knowledge

The children will stay overnight, sleeping on the classroom floors in separate boys' and girls' rooms. As they will be sleeping on the floor, please ensure your child brings items to help them feel comfortable, such as a roll mat, sleeping bag and pillow.

Each child will need to bring:

- A named water bottle
- Pyjamas
- A change of clothes
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- A coat
- Suitable outdoor footwear (e.g. old trainers or wellies)

Children may bring one personal comfort item, such as a teddy; however, this will be their responsibility to look after. We kindly ask that no mobile phones, electronic devices or games are brought to the sleepover.

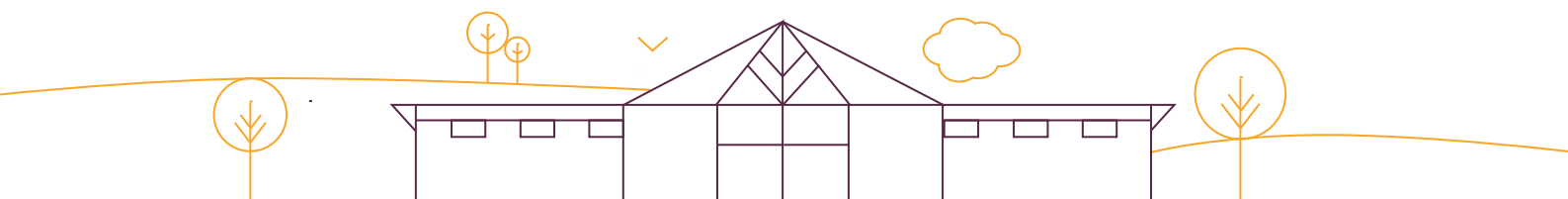
We will provide the children with dinner and breakfast. If you would prefer to provide your own dinner for your child, please indicate this on the Google form, link below. Water bottles can be refilled on site throughout the event. A breakdown of the food options available can be found below.

Dinner

- Domino's cheese and tomato pizza
- Domino's gluten free cheese and tomato pizza
- Vegetable sticks
- Ice cream (made by the children)
- Dairy free alternative dessert

Breakfast

Your child will have the choice of either toast or cereal along with a selection of fruit.





A cost of £5.85 per child is required to help cover the cost of providing dinner and breakfast, the cost of the pizza is £4.40 per child, if for dietary/medical reasons your child is unable to eat the pizza, please provide your child with an alternative dinner and in which case the contribution will be £1.45. You will see on your child's Scopay the amount of £5.85 owed, if your child is not having the pizza then please overtype the amount to £1.45 and the outstanding balance will be written off in due course. Please ensure your child has a named water bottle to drink from, we will be able to refill this onsite for them.
