

Year 5 Spring Newsletter

Welcome to a new term and Happy New Year! Year 5 have had a great launch to our new Spring project 'A New Home in Space' with our trip to the Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium. Throughout the rest of the term, the children will be learning about Space: planets, stars, orbital paths, space travel and much, much more! Throughout the project, the children will be considering Professor Stephen Hawking's statement, "I am convinced that humans need to leave Earth". This is a science-based project where the children will explore the movement of the Earth and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. The children will also study how different artists and musicians have interpreted the solar system, culminating with them producing their own artwork using chalk.

This term, we have deliberately put our celebration event in the middle of our project so that parents or carers who are able to come, can be part of the children's learning experience. There will be some collaborative making and doing for you all as we set a challenge connected with our Space themed project on Tuesday 5th March for CB5, Wednesday 6th March for SK5 and Friday 8th March for HWAP5 all starting from 9.00am until 10.00am.
