Please note that tickets are non-transferable, non-refundable and there will be no admission on the door without a ticket being purchased online in advance.

Numbers are limited and are only guaranteed once a ticket has been purchased online. Priority of tickets will be given to any parent helpers, so if you would be free to help at any of the Discos we would really appreciate it as we cannot run these events unless we have enough helpers. Please note that strictly **NO** parents can stay whilst the disco is on unless you have signed up to help. This is because we have to adhere to strict capacity numbers for the space being used.
