Dear Parents and Carers,

Excitingly, Year 4 are having a School Sleepover on Friday 21st March, which links to their project learning about the Arctic. During this opportunity, we believe that your child's independence, confidence and self-esteem will develop, alongside preparing them for future residentials and allowing them to create core Berrywood memories.

Your child will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of different activities. These activities will include navigating Berrywood using a map, making ice cream from scratch, applying their survival skills and knowledge during a team quiz and ending the night with an exciting Arctic documentary.

Your child will be staying one night, sleeping in the classrooms on the floor. The sleeping arrangements will be boy's rooms and girl's rooms. As they are sleeping on the floor, they will need to bring items that will make them feel comfortable. This could include a roll mat, sleeping bag and pillow. Your child will also need to bring a named water bottle, pyjamas, change of clothes, toothbrush, toothpaste, a coat and appropriate shoes for outdoors e.g., old trainers or wellies. Your child may choose to bring one personal item such as a teddy, but this is their responsibility to look after. Furthermore, we ask that NO mobiles phones, electronics or games are brought to the overnight stay.

We will be providing the children with dinner and breakfast, alternatively you can provide your child with their own dinner, please indicate this on the Google form. Please ensure your child has a named water bottle to drink from, we will be able to refill this onsite for them. Please see below a breakdown of the food options available.

Dinner

- Domino's cheese and tomato pizza
- Domino's gluten free cheese and tomato pizza
- Vegetable sticks
- Ice cream (made by the children)
- Dairy free alternative dessert

Breakfast

Your child will have the choice of either toast or cereal along with a selection of fruit.

Children will need to be dropped to the following classrooms; MF4 to Room 7, RH4 to Room 8 and LM4 to room 6, on Friday 21st March at 4:30pm, where the teachers will meet the children to register them and sign in any additional medication your child may require that is not already being held in school. Children need to be collected from the same classroom as they were dropped off at, at 9:00am on Saturday 22nd March, please include the name of the adult collecting your child on the Google form, link below.

A cost of £5.70 per child is required to help cover the cost of providing dinner and breakfast, the cost of the pizza is £4.02 per child, if for dietary/ medical reasons your child is unable to eat the pizza, please provide your child with an alternative dinner and in which case the contribution will be £1.67. Please ensure your child has a named water bottle to drink from, we will be able to refill this onsite for them.
