

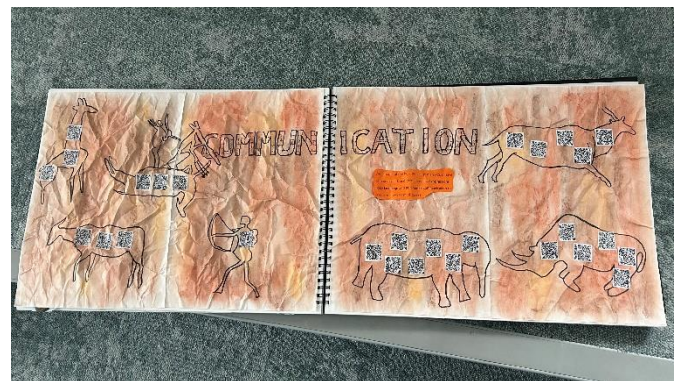
school opportunities to look out for:

- Children can from Yr5/6 have to chance to perform in the Christmas Pantomime, acting, singing and dancing their way through the performance.
- In the summer term, there is a Summer Production, which Yr5/6 children can participate in. They rehearse every week, after school for an hour. The performance involves acting, dancing and singing.
- At the end of their time in Year 6, all the children in the year perform at The Berry Theatre and celebrate their achievements.



We have a floor book for each year group, where we record the children's work. On this page, Year 3 are studying 'The Stone Age' and re-enacted a scene from the book 'Stig of the Dump'. Their performances are captured on a QR code behind the balloons.

As part of their Stone Age project, Year 3 thought about how people from that time would have communicated and made up their own language, using their faces and bodies.



Each lesson, we hang backdrops up to create a theatrical feel to the drama room and to

inspire the children to get into role. Often, the children have headdresses, masks and props for support too.

Year 4 study 'Ancient Egypt' in the Autumn and enjoyed becoming museum pieces, found in Tutankhamun's tomb. Their performances are captured forever inside the tomb on QR codes!
